Safety	PPE-Self Contained Breathing Apparatus (SCBA)	<i>202.01</i>

I. PURPOSE:

To ensure the respiratory safety of all firefighters of Campbell County Fire Department while working on the fireground or at training sessions.

II. SCOPE:

This SOP applies to all Campbell County Fire Department personnel qualified to wear and use Self Contained Breathing Apparatus (SCBA), to include, but not limited to; structural firefighters, hazmat team members, and firefighter trainees.

III. PROCEDURE:

1. Firefighters of the Campbell County Fire Department are required to use a Self Contained Breathing Apparatus, including face piece, under these circumstances:
 - 1.1. While working in an oxygen deficient and/or toxic atmosphere.
 - 1.2. While working in an atmosphere of intense heat, or if there is a potential of extreme heat.
 - 1.3. While performing ventilation operations.
 - 1.4. While working at an automobile fire that is still involved or still contains intense heat.
 - 1.5. When working in the presence of hazardous materials that are spilled or released that area toxic by inhalation or have an unknown hazard.
 - 1.6. During any training that simulates any of the above hazardous conditions.
