**PURPOSE:**

This policy defines the attendance requirements necessary to maintain good standing in the Campbell County Fire Department (CCFD) Cadet Program.

**SCOPE:**

This policy applies to all Cadets participating in the CCFD Cadet Program.

**POLICY:**

- A. Cadets are encouraged to participate in as many CCFD activities as possible.
- B. Cadets are expected to behave appropriately at all CCFD functions.
- C. In order to achieve and maintain active member status, a Cadet must earn a minimum of 10 points per quarter based on a calendar year. The point system is as follows:
  - a. Attending one Cadet business meeting = 1 point
  - b. Successful completion of one Cadet Training = 2 points
  - c. Successful completion of required classes (Standards, Hazmat Awareness, First Aid/CPR) = 15 points (5 per class)
  - d. Successful completion of firefighter training = 1 point (per 4 hours)
  - e. Successful completion of an optional department endorsed certifiable class (Cadet only needs to participate in entire session and pass the class, they do not need a certificate due to age restrictions of most classes) = 1 point per day
  - f. Participation on duty shift = 1 point per 4 hours
