PURPOSE:

This policy defines the appropriate behavior and the discipline procedure for the Campbell County Fire Department (CCFD) Cadet Program.

SCOPE:

This policy applies to all Cadets when representing the CCFD and the CCFD Cadet Program.

POLICY:

A. Behavior:

- a. Cadets must live a law-abiding life.
- b. Cadets must be honest with their fellow Cadets and other department personnel.
- c. Cadets must be respectful to their fellow cadets, firefighters, officers, Board members and members of the public, this includes family members.
- d. Cadets wearing CCFD attire must act in a professional manner as representatives of CCFD. CCFD attire includes anything with the department name or logo.
- e. Cadets involved in an illegal action are responsible for informing the Cadet Coordinator as soon as possible.
- f. The use of tobacco products is prohibited for all Cadets.
- g. Inappropriate language is not permitted.
- h. Cadets must maintain department confidentiality including information about an emergency scene and the individuals involved.
- i. Cadets will be allowed to participate in chaperoned Cadet Trips; all other CCFD out-of-town travel is prohibited.

B. Discipline:

- a. The Cadet Coordinator will discipline Cadets violating CCFD or CCFD Cadet Policies.
- b. Termination from the CCFD Cadet Program will be evaluated and approved by Division Chief of Operations on an individual basis.
