PURPOSE:

This policy defines the appropriate dress and uniforms for the Campbell County Fire Department (CCFD) Cadet Program.

SCOPE:

This policy applies to all Cadets when representing the CCFD and the CCFD Cadet Program.

POLICY:

- A. Cadets will be expected to wear the appropriate dress including: appropriate footwear, duty pants, Cadet shirt, and any other gear needed for all trainings and fire department functions.
- B. When attending a Cadet function not requiring a standard uniform, Cadets must dress in accordance with the school dress code.
- C. For any other function of the CCFD, a Cadet will contact their supervisors for dress requirements.
- D. A standard Cadet Uniform consists of blue BDU pants/green Nomex pants, Cadet t-shirt, blue web belt, and 8 inch black lace-up work boots.
- E. After attending three Cadet Meetings, new Cadets will receive the following uniform furnished by the CCFD: BDU pants/green Nomex pants, Cadet t-shirt, blue web belt. Cadets must furnish all other items at their own expense.
- F. Cadets will be expected to wear their hair in accordance with the CCFD Grooming Policy.
- G. Hats will not be worn backwards at any time.
